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**Important Notes:**

- \*AICE Diploma students must take 7 AICE classes AND pass the end of course exam for each of those classes.**
- \*AICE learners must achieve at least one credit from each of Groups 1 (Math & Science), Group 2 (Languages) and Group 3 (Arts & Humanities). A maximum of two credits can count from Group 4 (Interdisciplinary subjects), which is optional.**
- \*AICE Global Perspectives & Critical Thinking Skills are required courses.**
- \* AICE Diploma students will have 17 AICE course options to choose from at MSA.**
- \*AICE students also have the flexibility to take AP and Dual Enrollment courses, but will not count towards the AICE Diploma.**
- \*No Pert score required for AICE. Minimum 2.75 GPA required. 3 or higher on latest standardized assessments. Application must be completed, submitted, and approved.**
- \*AICE students have the option to finish by their Junior year.**
- \*AICE students will meet with the AICE Coordinator on a consistent basis to review progression and progress.**
- \*This is a suggested progression plan. Students have flexibility to take different courses based on needs and interests.**
