Eligibility Requirements

Acceptance into the MSA Cambridge Pre-AICE Program is contingent upon state assessment (or other standardized testing) scores, grades, discipline/attendance record, and successful completion of the application and essay. Students must be on level (3 or higher) on the state ELA & Math assessments, or comparable national exams. Out of state students will need to include the most recent standardized test scores and a transcript of their most recent grades.
